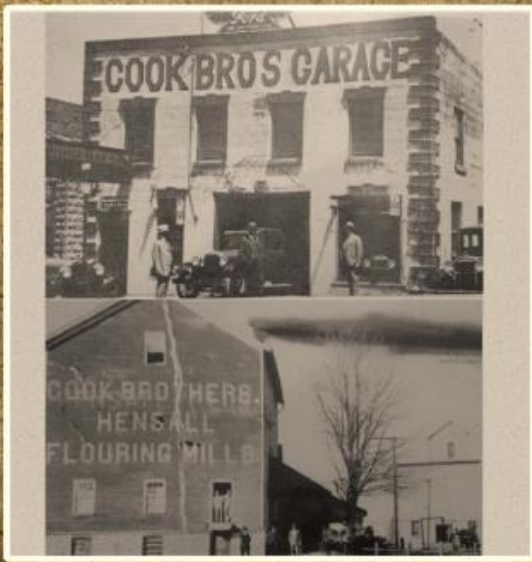


14 – Cook’s Building



Historic HENSALL



In 1911 brothers Norman and Cornelius Cook began selling Hupmobiles and later Hudson Essex cars. Cook Bros. Garage was very successful with new car sales reaching 100 and used cars sold as well, their inventory seldom dropped below 20-30 cars. They employed three mechanics, two salesman an office staff. Cook Bros. was Hensall’s first Ford Dealership.
