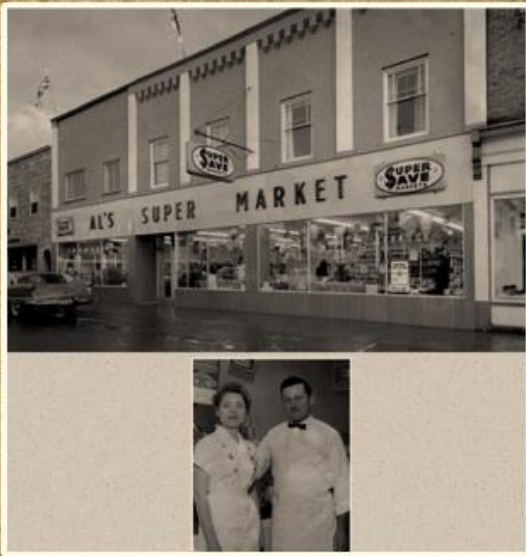


## # 13 – Al and Reta Scholl, Supersave

Business and industry have been a crucial part of the story of Hensall since the founding of the village by the Petty brothers. A number of historic business success stories involve family businesses with strong work ethics. An example of this is Al and Reta Scholl. During his service in World War 2, Al decided he wanted to open a butcher shop, with his war earnings Al purchased an abattoir and what would become the western part of their store from Harry MacMillan. The business would flourish and by the early 50's Al and Reta would expand their business buying the neighbouring grocery store from Mr. Keys and this became Al's Meat Market and Groceteria, the business would expand again when the Scholl's purchased Goodwin's dry goods store and became Al's Super Market in the 60's. Through business savvy and hard work businesses such as Scholl's and others in Hensall would become successes and attract customers from a broad area to the village.
